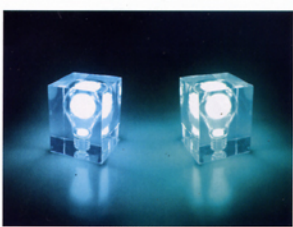
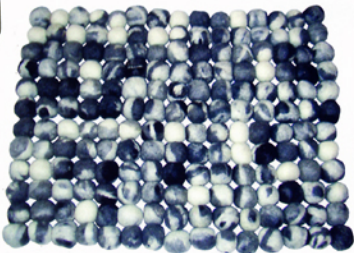
▼ **FITS LIKE A GLOVE**

British designers Edward Barber and Jay Osgerby have produced this chair with Swedish manufacturers Swedese. ► **UNDYED IN THE WOOL**

The wool is collected from Welsh flocks of fewer than six sheep—fleece from flocks of more than six sheep must be sold to the wool board, at a lower, pre-determined price. *Natural wool soft cobbles rug, from £250 for 87cm by 34cm by 5cm—other sizes can be made to order (Bione Lifestyle, as before)*



▲ **LIGHT RELIEF**

No wires, no fuss, no bills. The Glow Brick is a real light bulb encased in a solid acrylic brick, which recharges from natural light during the day.
